

CONNECTING AND CHARGING

- RLT206 has a waterproof handle. It is electrically safe and is designed for use in the bathroom. But it's not meant to be used while underneath the water.
- A full charge takes at least 24hours and enables approximately 6 weeks brushing. The constant blue LED ("Ch") indicates charging is in progress .Once fully recharged ,the light turns off automatically.
- Pull plug out of out let for saving energy, or leave it and keep the brush on charging base, there is no risk of overcharging of battery.

USING THE RLT206

Attach a brush head to the handle. You can use any kind of toothpaste. To avoid splashing, guide the brush-head to your teeth before switching the appliance on.

BRUSHING TECHNIQUE:

- Guide the brush head slowly from tooth to tooth.
- Hold the brush head in place for a few seconds before moving on to the next tooth.
- Brush the gums as well as the teeth. Start with the outside of the teeth, then the insides ending with the chewing surfaces.
- Do not scrub or press hard, simply let the brush do all the work.

BRUSHING MODES

The RLT206 offers five effective brushing modes for varying oral care needs. Features a auto shut-off after two minutes of brushing and a dentist-recommended auto-alert when brushing the same area for more than 30 seconds.

Clean -with up to 31,000 strokes per minute, exceptional mouth cleaning

White -with up to 41,000 strokes per minute, removes microscopic plaque and bacterialeft behind by other toothbrushes

Polish -With up to 48,000 strokes per minute,2X more plague will be effectively scrubbed away so fast

Massage -with up to 31,000 strokes per minute, strong to weak, weak to strong in a circle, gentle stimulation of gums

Sensitive -with weak 31,000 strokes per minute, gentle cleaning for sensitive areast

TWO MINUTE AUTO-TIMER:


The RLT206 is designed to reach the proven and best brushing timing. After 2 minutes of brushing, the device stops in 2 mins automatically.

HOW TO SWITCH BETWEEN BRUSING MODES:

- Power On/Off and brushing mode button(c).keep pressing this button, the operating sequence is power on, in Clean mode then White mode, then Polish mode, then Massage mode, then Sensitive mode, end power off. The device will trun of if pressing any mode over 5 Sec.
- The RLT206 automatically starts in the Clean mode when pressing the brushing mode button once.
- The RLT206 starts from Clean mode, and switch to White, Polish, Massage and Sensitive by pressing on/off button different times. The device will turn off after Sensitive mode pressing.

HOW TO SWITCH BETWEEN BRUSING MODES:

- Attach a brush head to the handle, You can use any kind of toothpaste, To avoid splashing, guide the brush-head to your teeth before switching the appliance on.
- Place the bristles against the teeth at a slight angle towards the gum line Press the button to turn the toothbrush, There are five cleaning modes.
- Take out an brush head (a) and the handle ,attach a brush head to the handle, there will be about 0.5 mm space between the brush head and the handle.
- Place the bristles against the teeth at a slight angle towards the gum line Press the button to turn the toothbrush. There are five cleaning modes. (Fig1)
- After brushing ,take down the brush head from the handle.(Fig2)
- · Rinse both the brush head and handle under running water and wipe them dry.



CLEANING RECOMMENDATIONS:

- After brushing, rinse you brush head thoroughly under running water.
- Remove the brush head from the handle and clean both parts separetely under running water. Then wipe them dry before you put the handle onto the charging unit.
- Before cleaning your charging unit, make sure you unplug the adaptor. Only use a dry or damp-dry cloth to wipe the surface of the charging unit.

important:Do not clean the charging unit by immersing it under running or still water.

- Place the charging unit onto a dry and safe place.
- Do not plug in the charging unit unit it is completely dry.
